State Representative Joseph Preston Jr. has granted a \$25,000 request from the Wilkinsburg Community Development Corporation (WCDC) for funds to enhance the Wilkinsburg business district. Funding, which is through the PA Department of Community and Economic Development, will include promotion and marketing, office equipment and organizational development.

In applying for the grant, WCDC requested funding to purchase banners for the business district; develop business district brochures; increase communications; develop and maintain a website; purchase equipment for community meetings; and conduct an annual plan review with the WCDC committees.

“A lot of good things are happening in Wilkinsburg right now,” said Rep. Preston. “I’m pleased to be able to fulfill this request, which should produce even more positive results.”

Wilkinsburg Mayor John Thompson, who also serves as chairman of the WCDC, said, “We are grateful to Representative Preston for his on-going support of our community. We have many needs and this grant will help us rebuild a prosperous business corridor.”
