Wilksburg Businesses — How Are We Doing?

Over the summer, Jennifer Alfieri, our intern from the University of Pittsburgh’s Graduate School of Public and International Affairs, conducted a survey of 30 Wilksburg businesses. The survey requested information about each business, their perspective of current conditions and their knowledge of the WCDC’s programs and initiatives.

This sample group of businesses employs 141 people, 49 of whom are Wilksburg residents; 61 are full time and 71 are part time. Of these businesses, 14 have a Business Plan, five of them received professional assistance in developing their plan, and eight of the businesses report that they are on track. Nine of the businesses report an increase in sales from last year. That’s good news for our local business district!

To what degree is the Business District safe? Over 50% of business owners surveyed say it is “Somewhat Better.” Additionally, 27 out of 30 businesses reported that they never or rarely have to call the police. But if they do, the police response is less than 5 minutes.

When the WCDC was established in 2008, community involvement drove the initial planning. Half of the businesses say they have participated in committee or business district safety meetings.

Michael Yellet, the WCDC’s Beautification Coordinator, helps to maintain our business district’s appearance. Rating the degree of street and sidewalk cleanliness, 83% of the businesses rated an improvement as “Somewhat or Extremely Better.” Many businesses appreciate the new litter receptacles and hope that more are installed as additional funding becomes available.
